





### **CAMPSITE RULES – ALL USERS**

- 1. Parking is only permitted in the car parking areas and vehicles (other than emergency) are not permitted past the middle gate and these must be kept clear at all times.
- 2. Tents / marquees MUST NOT be pitched on the central lawn or grassed areas.
- 3. Dogs are not permitted on site at any time (other than registered assistant dogs).
- 4. Open fires are permitted in the campfire circle or in altar fires which can be used on any of the camping pitches. Fires should not be left unattended and must be doused before you leave. Unused wood must be returned to the wood pile. Altar fires in cleaned condition to be returned. Ash bins are provided by the containers. STRICTLY NO GROUND FIRES.
- 5. Due to our sewage management system, please DO NOT use antibacterial soaps.
- 6. Always consult your own risk assessment before you start any activities on site.
- 7. Please respect our neighbours by keeping all unnecessary noise to a minimum and by not allowing any noise between the hours of 22.30 and 08.00.
- 8. Our site has boundary ditches along both sides and a stream at the bottom which must not be crossed. No damming of the boundary ditches or stream is allowed (they are vital for site drainage).
- 9. There are several Memorial items on site such as benches, plaques and places. Please respect these items and only use for their intended use. Picnic benches are available outside the Rowney building only and MUST NOT be moved.
- 10. All groups should appoint a supervisor to regularly check cleanliness and operational function of the site (including the toilets and buildings).
- 11. Trolleys are available to move kit from the car park to campsite and should be returned once used. No persons are permitted to ride on the trolleys.
- 12. Campers are responsible for the provision of their own First Aid.
- 13. This is a no smoking and no vaping site. We would ask that any smokers go outside the main gate.
- 14. All waste materials including recycling MUST be removed from site at the end of your visit

#### SCOUT CENTRE

- 1. Always consult your own risk assessment before you start any activities in the building.

- 3. Tables & Chairs MUST NOT be removed from the Scout Centre and taken outside for any reason. There is plenty of outdoor furniture for your use.
- 4. In order to keep the building clean, please ensure all outdoor footwear is removed.
- 5. All waste materials including recycling MUST be removed from site at the end of your visit.
- 6. Ensure that all taps and lights are turned off as well as the heating and hot water switch before you depart.
- 7. The building must be left clean and tidy, hoovers are provided.
- 8. Please do not leave ANY food in cupboards or fridges.
- 9. The kitchen comes fully equipped so please check that you have not removed any kitchen equipment by mistake.

### **ROWNEY BUILDING**

- 1. Always consult your own risk assessment and site activity risk assessment before you start any activities in the building.

- 3. Ensure that all taps and lights are turned off including heating and hot water before you depart.
- 4. The building must be left clean and tidy, brooms and mops are provided.
- 5. Please do not leave ANY food in cupboards or fridges.
- 6. The kitchen comes with very basic equipment; please make sure you bring your own with you.
- 7. All waste materials including recycling MUST be removed from site at the end of your visit.
