



Earleywood Campsite Self Hosting Reference Guide

Earleywood Campsite is a volunteer run Scout site. For groups who are self hosting, please refer to the guide notes below.

PLEASE MAKE SURE ANY KEYS ARE RETURNED TO THE KEY BOX AFTER UNLOCKING. THEY MUST REMAIN IN THE KEY BOX DURING YOUR STAY AND NOT PUT IN BAGS OR POCKETS.

On arrival, you will need to unlock the gate – the code will be emailed to you. We recommend you close the gate whilst on site.



The noticeboard contains useful information including a site map. Please take a look.



Please park considerately in the car park as other groups may also be on site. The car park to the right by the Scout Centre is priority parking for those who have booked the Scout Centre.

The entrance to the Scout Centre and Rowney Building are on the far side of the buildings. If you have booked one of the buildings, you will be emailed the code required.





Scout Centre: you may need to turn on the main heaters and water heater on arrival. Please **TURN OFF** again after use before locking up.



Rowney Building: Please **TURN OFF** any heaters in the hall after use as well as the hot water switch in the kitchen. If you are running indoor archery or rifle shooting with your own instructor in the Rowney Building, the codes for the cupboards will be emailed to you.



If you are running climbing, abseiling or crate stacking with your own instructor, or using the traversing wall, the climbing compound code will be emailed to you.



There is a switch for the outdoor floodlights to light the picnic area outside the Rowney Building. Please **TURN OFF** after use.



The toilet block is left unlocked. Please check it is clean and tidy before departure. There are cleaning materials in the toilet block.

On departure, please check any switches you have turned on are **TURNED OFF!** If you are the only group on site, please close and lock the front gate on exit.
